

The Dandenong Ranges



Let Harlan Coach Tours take you on a **half-day tour** into the magnificent Dandenong Ranges, situated on the north-eastern outskirts of Melbourne.

This is a trip for those who love the flora and fauna. From the native vegetation such as the magnificent Mountain Ash forests and the tree-fern gullies to some of the wonderful European gardens that grow so well here. There are also many quaint little villages nestled in these hills.

First we head out through Melbourne's Eastern suburbs and up into the hills to Belgrave. From here we enter the Dandenong Ranges National Park and stop at Grant's Picnic Ground. The birdlife here is abundant and the parrots come down to feed from the hands of the tourists. We will have a Devonshire morning tea here before continuing on through the small town of Monbulk and past one of Melbourne's major water supplies, Silvan Reservoir.

Close by is Tesselaar's Nursery famous for its Tulip festival in the Spring. We stop here briefly to view their "Trial and Display Garden" which has something to offer all year round.

Back on the bus and we head further North toward Wandin where we will stop at the Warratina Lavender Farm. This farm began development in 1991 replacing an old orchard. Enjoy a stroll along the lavender rows breathe the fresh country air, and enjoy the view of distant hills. Perhaps purchase a few lavender products before we return to Melbourne via the Warburton and Maroondah Highways.
