Itinerary

Approximately 8:30am	Depart Melbourne

10:30am	Arrive at Bell's Beach - one of the most famous surf beaches in Australia and home of the 'Bells Classic' international surfing competition held every Easter. Also home to the most beautiful toilet block you are ever likely to see.
11:00am	Make a brief stop at Memorial Arch , which is a tribute by the soldiers who built the road for the soldiers who didn't come home from the war.
12:30pm	Lunch in the beautiful coastal town of Apollo Bay (included). A great place to swim (maybe not today) with some good shopping.
1:30pm	Depart Apollo Bay and travel through the beautiful Great Otway National Park, home to ancient rainforests.
3:00pm	Arrive at the incredible Twelve Apostles . But how many are left? Voted, one of the top 5 views in Australia, this is a place that is much better in real life than in a photo.
3:45pm	Visit Loch Ard Gorge and learn of the tragic story of how the place got its name. There is a lot to explore in this area so get your walking shoes on and your cameras ready.
4:30pm	Make a brief snack/toilet stop at Port Campbell.
5:00pm	View the famous London Bridge before heading back to Melbourne via Colac.
8:00pm	Expected arrival back in Melbourne after taking a quick break at least once on the way back.
