



Penguin Express



This tour is intended for those who wish to experience one of Australia's most popular attractions, Phillip Island's famous Penguin Parade, but have limited time.

Each night at sunset, Little Penguins returning ashore after a day's fishing will amaze you. See the world's smallest penguin in its natural habitat from viewing stands and boardwalks. As the sun fades in the sky, Little Penguins waddle up the beach to the safety of their homes in the sand dunes.

Harlan Coach Tours will collect your group from your accommodation or club mid afternoon. The time varies depending on the time of year as the Penguin Parade occurs at sunset.

On the way we will take a short break at Maru Crafts and Fauna Park in Grantville. Here you can grab a snack or an Australian souvenir. Their fauna park, including an animal nursery, is worth a look if we have sufficient time and the entrance fee is very reasonable.

Then we cross the bridge at San Remo onto Phillip Island and make our way to the Penguin Parade at the Southern end of the island. On the way we pass the racetrack where the Australian leg of the Motorcycle Grand Prix is held.

After the Parade it is back to the coach for the return trip to your hotel or club. The total trip time is approximately 6 hours.
